- First Student is a subsidiary of a major global company called FirstGroup.
- FirstGroup is a United Kingdom-based transport provider with operations in the United States, U.K. and Canada.
- In 2009, FirstGroup America's revenue totaled \$4.672 billion, and its profits totaled over \$480.2 million.
- The company is led by Chief Executive Officer Moir Lockheed, whose salary, bonuses, benefits and stock options package totaled more than \$1.3 million in 2009. His pension plan was valued at more than \$11.9 million in March 2009.

Here at Home

- In 2007 FirstGroup PLC announced their \$3.4 billion takeover bid for Laidlaw International and the merger was approved by the U.S. Department of Justice.
- First Student is now the largest school bus carrier in the U.S. and Canada, operating over 62,000 buses in 39 states and three provinces.
- First Student holds contracts at approximately 1,500 school districts and transports almost four million students to school each day.

The answer is clear—First Student can afford to treat us right.

What we can't afford is to sit by and not take action. We are working together so we can improve standards for all school bus workers. The Teamsters now represent over 75,000 members in the school bus and transit industry, with more than 34,300 Teamsters at FirstGroup.
